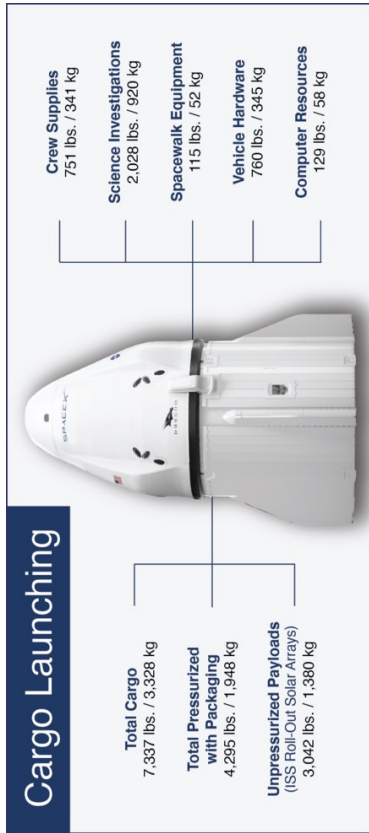


The Falcon 9 first stage from this launch will land 7-1/2 minutes after launch on an autonomous landing barge in the Atlantic Ocean off the coast of South Carolina. The landing will be too far from launch viewing sites to be seen, though it should be visible on the SpaceX Launch Webcast. <http://SpaceX.Com/live>

The SpaceX Dragon 2 spacecraft named Resilience will launch at the Kennedy Space Center. About 2-1/2 minutes after launch, the first stage will shut down, and 3 seconds later the second stage will ignite which will push the Dragon capsule into a matching orbit with the ISS. As the Dragon reaches its preliminary orbit, it will begin a series of thruster firings to reach the International Space Station. It will take about 24 hours to arrive at Station.

SpaceX-23, (also known as CRS-23) is the 23rd Commercial Resupply Services mission provided by SpaceX for NASA. It is an uncrewed cargo mission to the ISS (International Space Station). It is packed with more than 7,300 pounds of research equipment, crew supplies, and hardware.
